Councilor Bollinger congratulated the Village of Minoa on their successful annual field days.

Councilor Green gave an update on the deer management meeting that was held on June 4th. Councilor Green stated that the committee reviewed the results of the 2018/2019 deer management program. Councilor Green stated that the deer management plan for 2019/2020 will include additional educational programs and more data collection from residents via the town website.

Councilor Green stated that the Annual Manlius Historical Society meeting will be held on June 19th.

Councilor Green gave an update on the Critical Response Committee.

Councilor Marzola stated that the Village of Minoa will be hosting 2019 Octoberfest and discussed police enforcement for the large crowd that may attend.

Councilor Rossetti discussed the lack of air conditioning at the Town of Manlius Police Department. Councilor Rossetti stated that town may need to provide temporary cooling devices until the air conditioning in the department is repaired.

Councilor Loeffler stated that the Planning Process Committee met and finalized the list of items that need to be reviewed in the Town Code. Councilor Loeffler stated that the list of code review items has been sent to General Code as part of the codification process. Councilor Loeffler stated that the Planning Process Committee is trying to prioritize the work and information that has been presented to the committee.

Town Clerk Weber stated that after a recent review of town records she found that the February Supervisors Report approval was not recorded in previous minutes.
