1. The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m.

- Chief Crowell gave a personnel report. There are currently 3 open positions at the department and there is a possibility of a transfer candidate.
- Chief Crowell distributed the 2019 goals and objectives.

- Chief Crowell discussed the strategic plan.
- Chief Crowell reported progress on completing the One Mind Pledge. Chief Crowell stated that some officers in the department have completed mental health first aid training.
- Chief Crowell reported that Glatfelter has reviewed the department from a liability perspective and Glatfelter stated that the department is “doing great things”.
- Chief Crowell stated that the department is going to have to temporarily relocate for renovations by the Village of Manlius. Discussion ensued regarding the process and cost for the temporary move.
