## REGISTRATION INFORMATION



Preference is given to Town of Manlius residents. A completed registration/medical form must accompany payment for all programs. A separate form must be completed for each program and each participant. Additional forms may be obtained from the recreation office or you may make copies of the form in this brochure. No phone-in registration is accepted unless otherwise stated. Participants are not registered for a program until payment and a registration form are received in the recreation office. No confirmation of registration is made for any programs; you will be notified only if the program is full, cancelled or there has been a change. Registration is taken on a first come first serve basis, therefore, there is a chance that some programs will be full when you register.

**PLEASE NOTE:** There will be a \$20.00 service charge imposed on all returned checks.

**REFUNDS:** If a program is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment, then all persons registered will receive a full refund. Refunds for participant cancellation will be given through the day before the program starts (minus a \$5.00 service charge). No refunds will be given after that or if the cancellation puts us below the minimum number required to run the program. NO refunds will be given to one time programs unless cancellation is received 48 hours in advance of the program.

**NOTE:** Recreation programs do not carry accident insurance for participants.

## OFFICE FOR THE AGING OVERVIEW OF SERVICES

The Onondaga County Office for the Aging is the federally designated Area Agency on Aging for Syracuse and Onondaga County. The Federal Older Americans Act, along with the New York State Community Services for the Elderly Act, authorize our agency to plan, develop and coordinate programs and services for approximately 83,000 county residents age 60 and older. The Office for the Aging is made up of several individual, award-winning programs, our largest being the Senior Nutrition Program, providing nutritious meals and nutrition education through home delivered meals, congregate dining and nutrition counseling. Our Community Services for the Elderly program provides services to frail and low-income elderly, such as information and assistance, transportation, social day programs and elder abuse education. Energy Programs, HEAP (Home Energy Assistance Program) and WRAP (Weatherization Referral Assistance Program, offer heating, cooling and weatherization assistance to income eligible seniors. Services provided by our Expanded In-Home Services for the Elderly (EISEP) Program include case management, respite and non-medical home care. The Office for the Aging provides Health Promotion programs through our Fit For the Next Fifty program, wellness classes at local senior centers, and free health insurance counseling.

The dam was constructed in 1952 at a cost of \$25 million and provides flood protection to the lower Genesee River Valley, including Rochester. Opened in 1913, the museum has displays of Native American artifacts collected by Mr. Letchworth, such as stone tools and pottery. We will then meet our guide for a tour of the park itself; 14,350 acres of magnificent scenery encompassing the Genesee Gorge and the river winding below it.

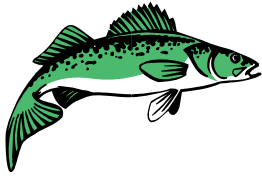

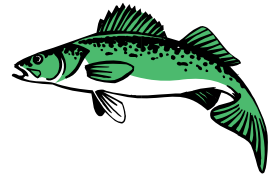

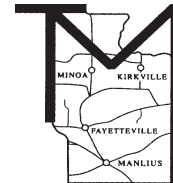

# BRUSH PICK-UP INFORMATION

The Fall and the Christmas Holiday season are fast approaching! The following is some important information for Town of Manlius residents who are signed up in the bi-weekly Brush removal district\*:

- 1) Brush is classified as leaves, grass clippings, smaller branches and twigs.

**No dirt, rocks, stumps or sod.**

- 2) Brush must be in a rigid container(s) (either plastic or metal) or in a biodegradable bag(s).

**Plastic bags are not acceptable.**

- 3) If you put out containers, they cannot weigh more than 75 lbs.

- 4) If you put out limbs/branches, they must be no longer than 5 feet long, no more than 3 inches in diameter, and: must be bundled and tied with string or twine. No wire. If not bundled, they must be contained in a rigid container.



There will be two Christmas tree pick-ups in January 2012:

- The week of January 9<sup>th</sup>
- The week of January 23<sup>rd</sup>

The Christmas tree pick-up guidelines are as follows:

- Real trees only. No artificial trees.
- Remove all plastic bags, lights, stands, tinsel and ornaments.
- The trees do not have to be cut up. They can be put out whole.
- No wreaths or garlands due to wire and Styrofoam (put these items in the trash).

If your dog is currently licensed you will receive renewal notices and replacement tags from the Town of Manlius Clerk's Office just before the expiration of your license.

If your dog is not licensed it should be. Many dogs in the Town of Manlius are not licensed simply because the owners were not aware that all dogs must be licensed in accordance with New York State Law. This letter is intended to make the licensing process easier for you.
