1. The meeting was called to order at 5:01 p.m.

2. **Minutes**

A motion was made by Member McGrew and seconded by Member Schepp to approve the minutes of December 22, 2021. Abstain: Member Nicholson, Member Waters. The motion passed unanimously.

3. **New Business**

Chief Crowell discussed difficulties hiring and how difficult it is to find candidates. Chief Crowell stated that the hiring / candidate issue is occurring nationwide.

Chief Crowell presented the Police Committee with a hiring incentive program and asked for the committee to send a recommendation to the Town Board. The committee had a lengthy discussion about the hiring issues the department is facing.

Chief Crowell propped an amendment to the letter of understanding that is part of the PBA Agreement that was signed on December 10, 2020. Chief Crowell asked that four officers be grandfathered into the letter of understanding.

A motion was made by Member Schepp and seconded by Member McGrew to recommend that the Town Board approve the update to the side letter of understanding that was signed on December 10, 2020, to include four additional officers. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Member Nicholson and seconded by Member McGrew to recommend the Town Board approve the hiring incentive & retention support program as recommended by Chief Crowell. The motion passed unanimously.

- Chief Crowell stated that the Citizens Police Academy will be starting soon.
- Chief Crowell stated that the PBA Award Banquet will be on April 16<sup>th</sup>

- Chief Crowell stated that the Town Board approved Cordico an officer wellness mobile app.
- Chief Crowell stated that the department will be taking over the investigation of bad checks.
- Chief Crowell discussed recent crimes and incidents in the Town.
- Chief Crowell stated that all the officers in field training are doing well.
- Chief Crowell announced that Captain Schafer is retiring.
