New York State's New Solar Framework is bringing about incentives for Communities and their residents. Similar to Community Choice Aggregation (CCA), the Public Service Commission will soon approve an Opt-out Community Solar Program for Municipalities. This will enable local governments to provide Solar for all their eligible residents at a guaranteed savings without the need to install solar panels.

Good Community Solar helps those in need:

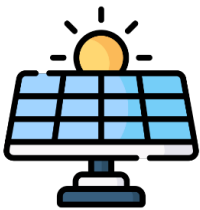
Good Community Solar also supports the state's mandate to provide guaranteed savings to Low-to-Moderate income (LMI) account holders. Those who are Assistance Program Participants will likely be enrolled first and prioritized for savings without any costs.

How it works:

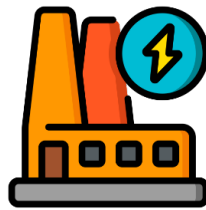
The way it works is that Good Energy's solar farms built in various utilities across the state are producing local power and resiliency to New York's Electrical Grid System. Through NYSERDA's Solar CDG program incentives are paid out to developers and to anyone that subscribes to the Solar Farm. Even if it's hundreds of miles away. 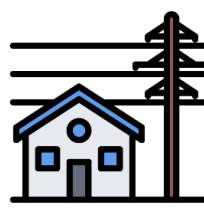
